¹ The LORD detests the use of dishonest scales, but he delights in accurate weights.

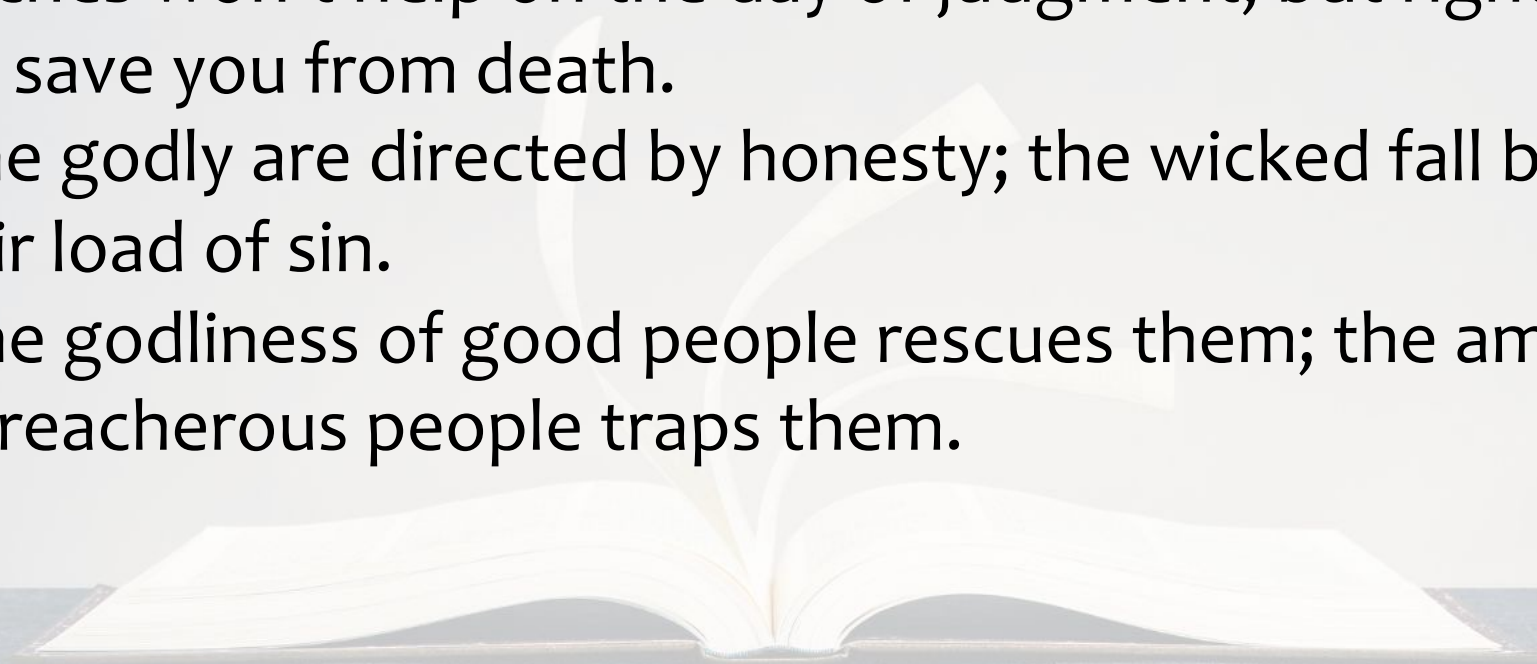
² Pride leads to disgrace, but with humility comes wisdom.

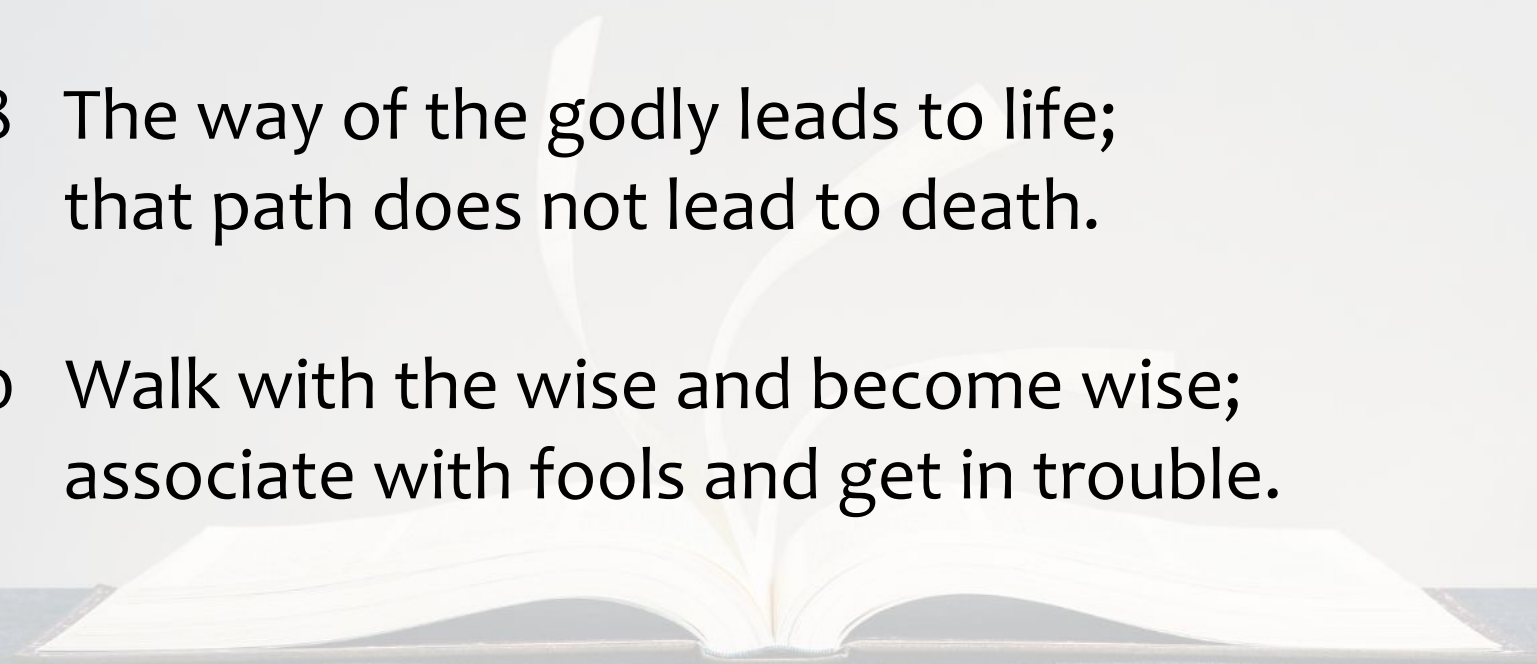


Prov. 2:8 He guards the paths of the just
