- ¹ In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
- ² The earth was formless and empty, and darkness covered the deep waters. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters.
- ³ Then God said, “Let there be light,” and there was light.
- ⁴ And God saw that the light was good. Then he separated the light from the darkness.

The biblical creation account is **unique**. Not only in the account it gives of how creation came into existence, but also in the **character** of the God it portrays.

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- Humanity isn't created as **slave labour** for the gods
- Creation is declared **good**

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Genesis tells us there is a Creator, and His creation is *intentional*, *ordered*, *generous*, and *good*.

- ¹ The heavens proclaim the glory of God.
The skies display his craftsmanship.
- ² Day after day they continue to speak;
night after night they make him known.
- ³ They speak without a sound or word;
their voice is never heard.
- ⁴ Yet their message has gone throughout the earth, and
their words to all the world.
